As another fantastic school year comes to an end, we are pleased to share some of the many ways safeguarding has remained at the heart of everything we do at The Stable School. This year has been filled with valuable opportunities for our learners, families and staff to develop their knowledge, confidence and skills needed to stay safe both in school and beyond.



Throughout the year, we have welcomed a range of external experts into school to support our safeguarding curriculum. Our learners took part in informative sessions on the dangers of vaping, learning about the risks associated with vaping and where to access support to stop.

We also welcomed the Fire Service, who delivered an engaging whole-school assembly on fire safety, including what to do in the event of a fire and the importance of evacuating quickly and safely. In addition, firefighters worked with individual learners in smaller, interactive sessions, providing practical advice and encouraging thoughtful discussions about staying safe.

Water safety has also been a key focus this year. We were delighted to welcome the RNLI, who shared essential advice about staying safe around water. Combined with our weekly swimming lessons, these experiences have helped our learners build both confidence and important life-saving knowledge in and around the water.

Our Safeguarding Panel has continued to play an active role in promoting safety across the school. This year, members explored the topic of online safety, learning about the platforms they regularly use, how to recognise potential risks, and how to stay safe while exploring the internet. We have also hosted parent workshops on online safety and social media, helping families stay informed about emerging platforms and offering practical guidance on keeping their children safe online.

This year also saw the launch of our Blossoms Group for our female learners, providing a welcoming, supportive and safe space to talk openly and positively about periods. We are excited to build on this next year by developing more groups that give learners safe, inclusive spaces to discuss the issues that matter most to them.



We would also like to extend a warm welcome to Kerry who has progressed into as our Designated Safeguarding Lead following Linda's well-earned retirement.

Kerry has already brought fresh ideas and exciting plans to ensure safeguarding continues to be at the centre of everything we do at The Stable School.

BEACH SAFETY

We are lucky to have so many blue flag beaches on our doorstep. Here are our 4 top tips to remember when visiting a beach this holiday:

1.) Always go to a lifeguarded beach- the RNLI patrol 240 beaches across the UK in the Summer. Always visit a lifeguarded beach to stay safe in and out the water

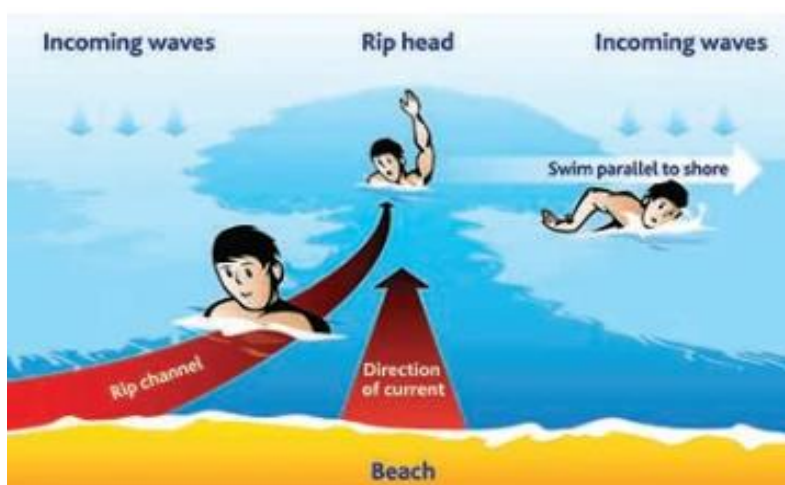


2.) Make sure your children know how to call for help. When down the beach and in trouble, call 999 and ask for the coastguard. Or find a lifeguard who will help you both in and out of the water.

3.) Float to live: if you find yourself in the water, or you fall in unexpectedly, float to live. Relax and try to breathe normally. Tilt your head back and submerge your ears. Use your hands to help you stay afloat.



4) Know the risks and what to do! "Rip tides" are common on our beaches, know how to safely get out of one.

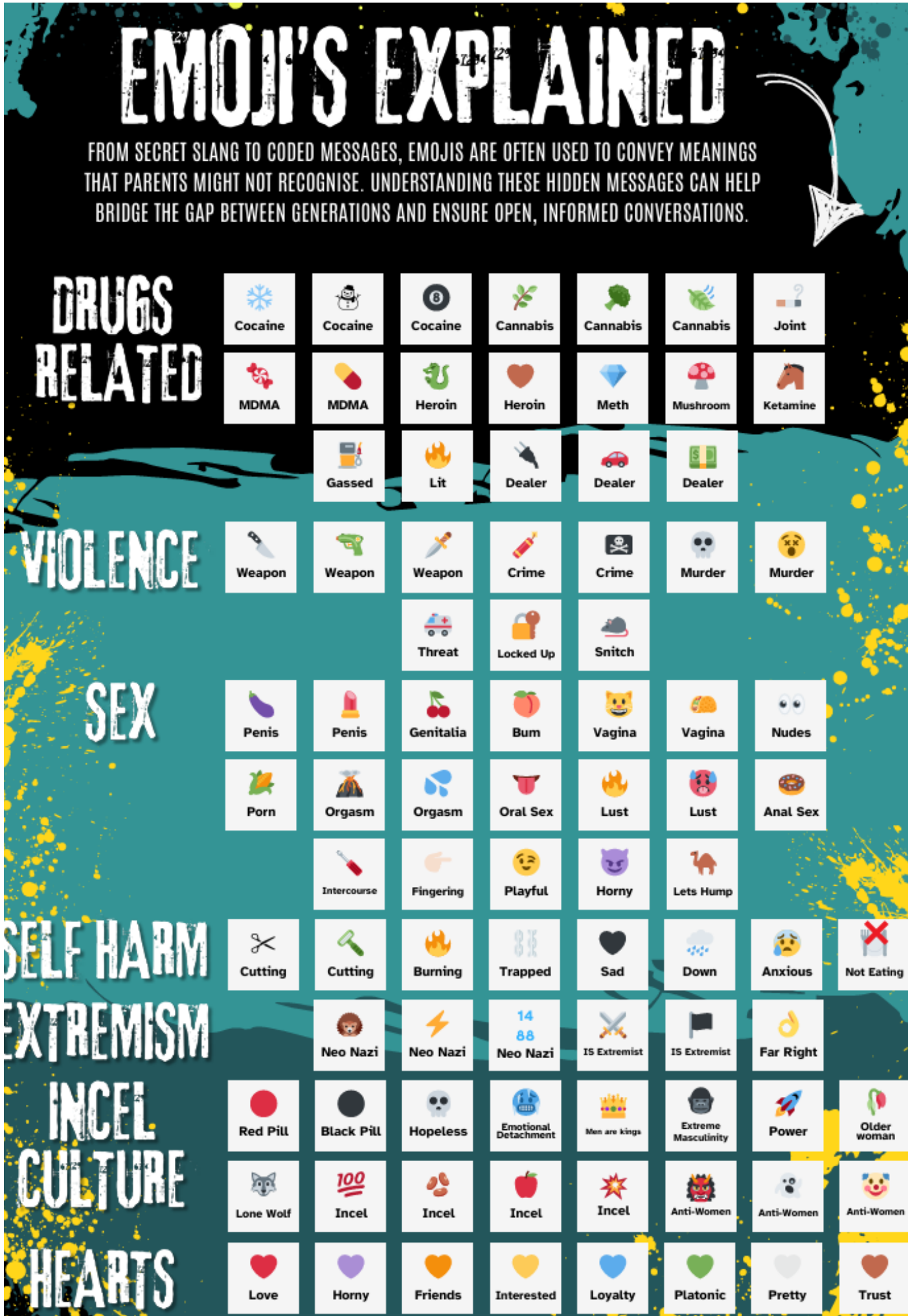
